Important information for exhibitors of Cattle

The movement of cattle to and from an Agricultural show within the state must be recorded on AIM. Owners who plan to move animals to a Show must obtain a certificate of compliance prior to the movement of animals. No destination should be nominated when you are applying for a certificate.

At the show the movement notification section of the certificate should be completed by the keeper and the show secretary who should clearly indicate the show number on the form.

Ultimate responsibility for fulfilling this requirement lies with the show secretary. Completed forms should be sent by the show secretary to the local DVO within 7 days of the show.

A blank application form (NBAS 31K) for compliance certificate is attached to the centre of this book for you to complete and fax or post off to obtain the certificate which you then bring to the show with you.
